India Humanity Foundation (IHF) is committed to serving the common man through impactful, scalable and sustainable development programs. Founded in 2012, over the years we have touched lives across Literacy, Disaster Management, Health, Hunger Alleviation, Water & Environment and Empowering Girls. Some of our key milestones include:

## Literacy

Through the T-E-A-C-H program, IHF has trained 2,30,000 teachers, helped 3,00,000 adults become literate, and reintegrated 50,000 out-of-school children while revitalizing 4,000 schools.



## Disaster Management

IHF distributed 15,000 Shelter Kits to disaster-hit families and contributed ₹116 crore to the PM CARES Fund, showcasing its commitment to disaster recovery.

## Health

IHF has provided over 1,500 pediatric heart surgeries for children across India and neighboring countries, earning praise from the Hon'ble Prime Minister in his Mann Ki Baat address.



## Hunger Alleviation

IHF distributed 30,60,000 meals, 4,20,000 community meals, and 7 lakh food packets worth ₹5 crores to underserved communities.

## Water & Environment

Check dams and waterbodies rejuvenated in Odisha removing millions of cubic meters of silt.

In the Sundarbans, IHF planted 6,000 mangroves with 7.5 km fencing to strengthen climate resilience.

IHF recognizes excellence by honouring 50,057 outstanding educators with the "Nation Builder Award," fostering a culture of dedication and innovation in teaching. By strengthening teachers' skills and celebrating their contributions, the program significantly improves student learning outcomes and supports the broader development of the education sector across India.

India Humanity Foundation (IHF) drives educational transformation through its E-learning initiative, making education accessible and engaging for under-resourced schools. By introducing Smart Classrooms and curriculum-aligned digital content, IHF bridges the digital divide and enhances learning outcomes.

In partnership with NCERT, IHF contributed to the National E-Vidya Program, launched by the Prime Minister, reaching millions of students in over 50,000 schools via digital and D2H platforms. States like Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, and Punjab have prioritized extending these tools to underserved communities. Recognizing excellence, NCERT earned the UNESCO award in 2022 for its multimedia content during the COVID lockdown.

India Humanity Foundation (IHF) is steadfast in its mission of **"Making India Totally Literate"** by addressing the literacy gap among marginalized populations. Through its Adult Literacy Program, IHF equips individuals with essential literacy skills, fostering self-reliance and dignity.

Using innovative models, Vidya involves community teachers (Akshar Saathis) for educating non-literate adults, while under Diksha model school students tutor adult learners. With Vidya Centres established nationwide through over 50 NGOs across 20 states and Diksha implemented in 42 schools. Both the models have successfully made over 3,00,000 adults' literate to date. This impactful initiative continues to drive significant progress toward a fully literate and empowered India.

To date, the program has empowered over 50,000 children, offering them renewed hope and a structured pathway to quality education. This initiative continues to play a critical role in bridging educational gaps and building brighter futures for children.

The Happy School Program by India Humanity Foundation (IHF) aims to transform state-funded schools into secure, attractive, and joyful learning spaces for students and teachers. By upgrading infrastructural and co-scholastic facilities, the program fosters a positive school environment that boosts enrolment, improves attendance, increases retention, and enhances student learning outcomes.

As part of the initiative, IHF established 4,000 libraries under the Padho Bharat program, distributing over 1,00,000 books to schools, orphanages, and educational institutions. This effort enriches educational resources, supports holistic child development, and creates vibrant spaces where students can thrive academically and personally.

## Disaster Management

India Humanity Foundation (IHF) has been at the forefront of disaster management, delivering over 15,000 Shelter Kits to families affected by natural calamities across India and neighboring regions. Each kit contains 52 essential items, including tarpaulin sheets, mosquito nets, clothing, utensils, hygiene products, and safety tools, ensuring dignity and basic living needs during recovery.

Major relief operations include Bihar (2,500 kits, 2008), Nepal and West Bengal (1,200+ kits, 2015), and Orissa (1,000 kits, 2013). Regular distributions across disaster-prone areas like Kerala, Karnataka, and Assam further strengthen community resilience. IHF also contributed ₹116 crore to the PM CARES Fund for COVID-19 relief efforts.





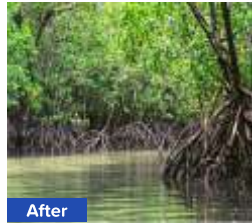
## Water & Environment

India Humanity Foundation (IHF) focuses on Water and Environment, promoting sustainable resource management, ecosystem restoration, and climate resilience across India. Through community participation like Shramdaan, IHF is building check dams ensuring rainwater harvesting and long-term water security. In Odisha, in partnership with the BCKIC Foundation, IHF rejuvenated waterbodies in Chandrapur Block, Raygada District, removing millions of cubic meters of silt to rejuvenate ponds to supply water throughout the year.

In the Sundarbans, IHF has undertaken mangrove restoration, planting over 6,000 mangroves across 11.62 km with 7.5 km of fencing.



## Empowering Girls

Empowering girls is central to building a just, healthy, and progressive society. India Humanity Foundation (IHF) is deeply committed to ensuring that every girl has the right to live with dignity, confidence, and good health. Under this vertical, IHF is launching large-scale initiatives focused on Cervical Cancer Vaccination, Menstrual Hygiene Management and Nutrition addressing two critical aspects of girls' health and well-being.

Through awareness campaigns, school-based vaccination drives, and capacity-building sessions, these initiatives aim to protect adolescent girls from preventable diseases, and break taboos surrounding menstruation. By fostering a supportive environment involving parents, teachers, and communities, IHF strives to empower girls with knowledge and preventive healthcare.

The Saving Little Hearts Program by India Humanity Foundation (IHF) ensures financial constraints do not prevent underprivileged children from accessing life-saving heart surgeries. By partnering with leading cardiac hospitals across India, the program has facilitated over 1,500 paediatric Heart Surgeries, offering critical care to those in need.

Recognized nationally, including by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in his **Mann Ki Baat** address, the program also extends support internationally to children from underdeveloped countries. This initiative underscores IHF's commitment to healthcare equity, transforming lives and offering vulnerable children a chance at healthier, brighter futures.

- **Nutrikit Distribution Program:** Delivered 30,60,000 meals to school children and orphanages, including nutritious items like dalia, jaggery, ghee, and milk powder, valued at ₹2 crores.
- **Ration and Care Kits:** Distributed kits containing staples like rice, dal, and oil, facilitating 4,20,000 meals for underserved communities.
- **Food packets:** Provided 7 lakh food packets featuring premium items like Bournvita and biscuits, worth ₹3 crores.
- These initiatives reflect IHF's dedication to combating hunger and improving the nutritional well-being of vulnerable populations.

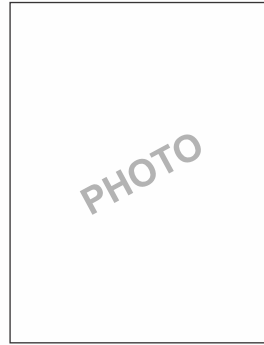

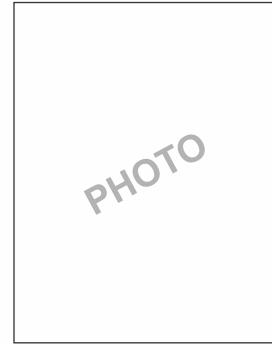
