Our Delivery Model & USP



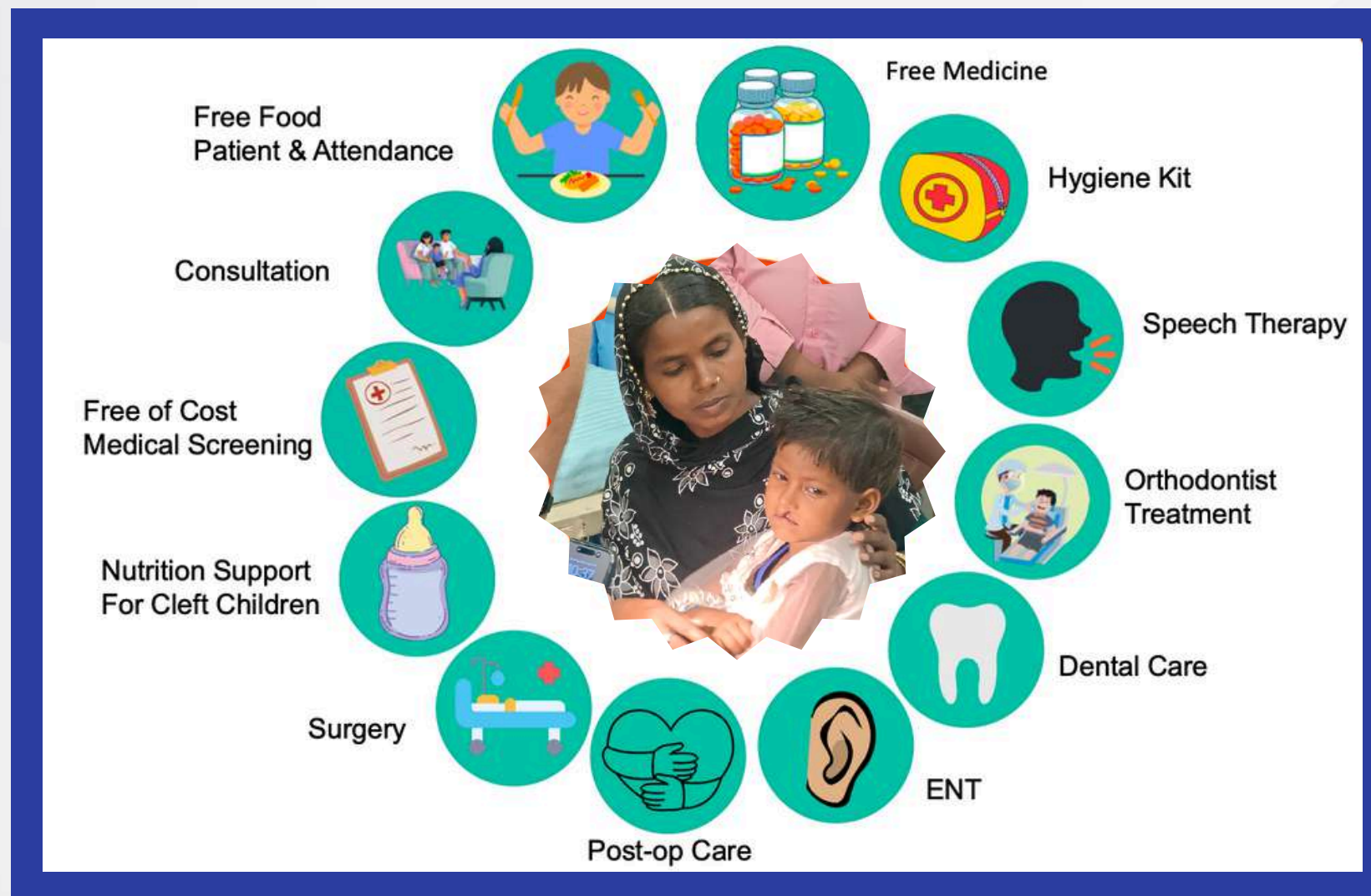
Mission Model

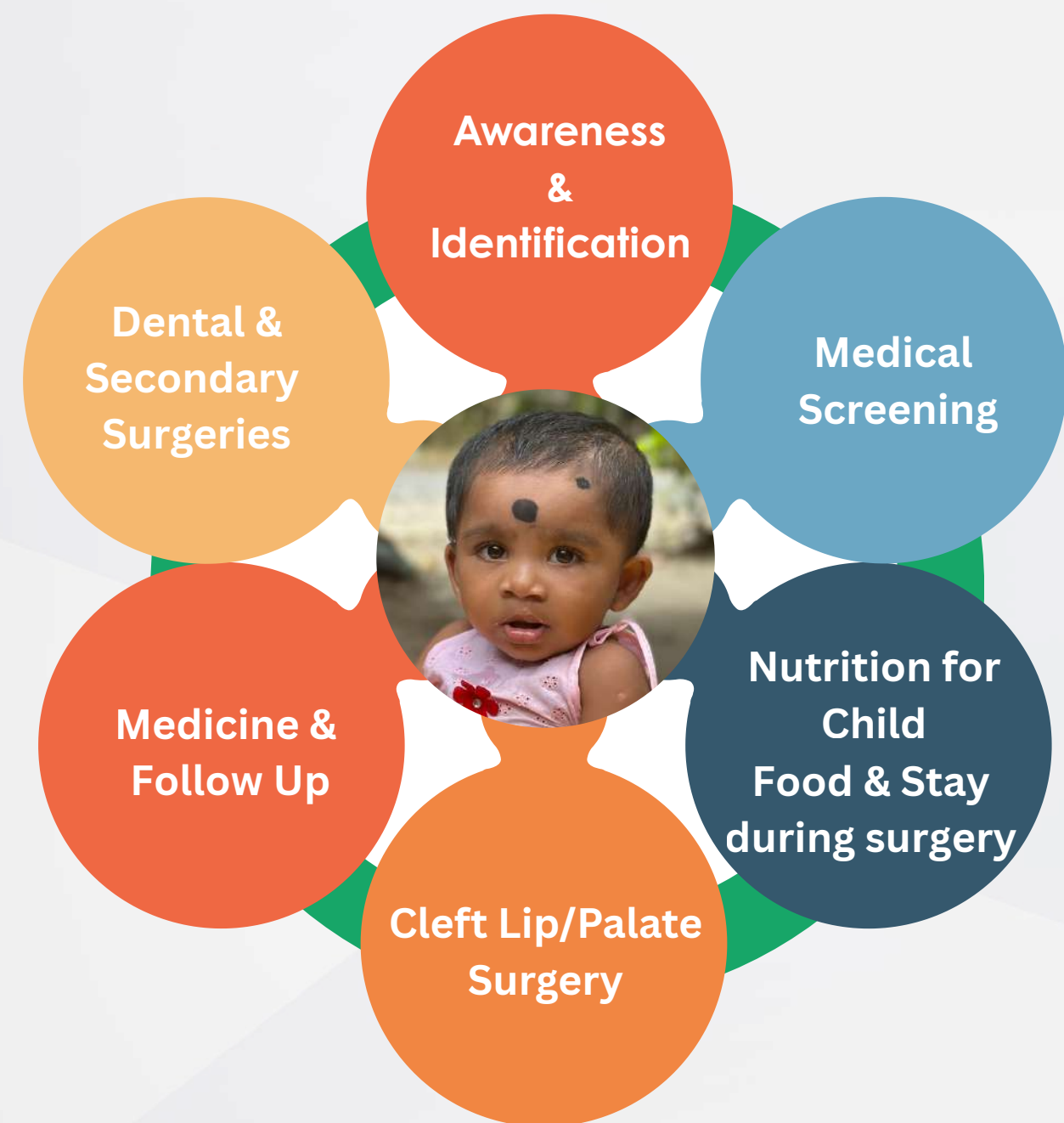
Centre Model

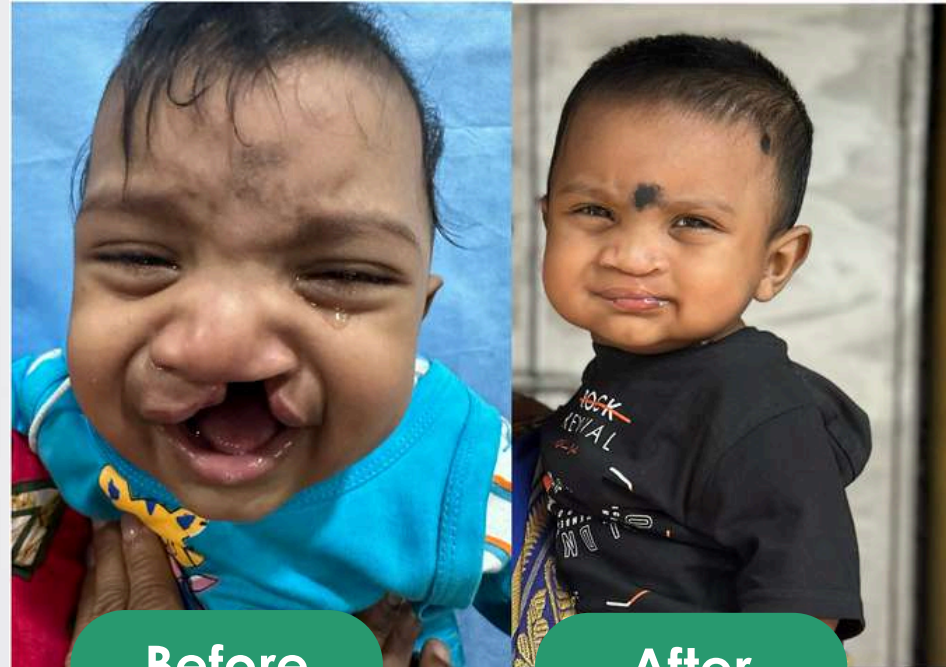

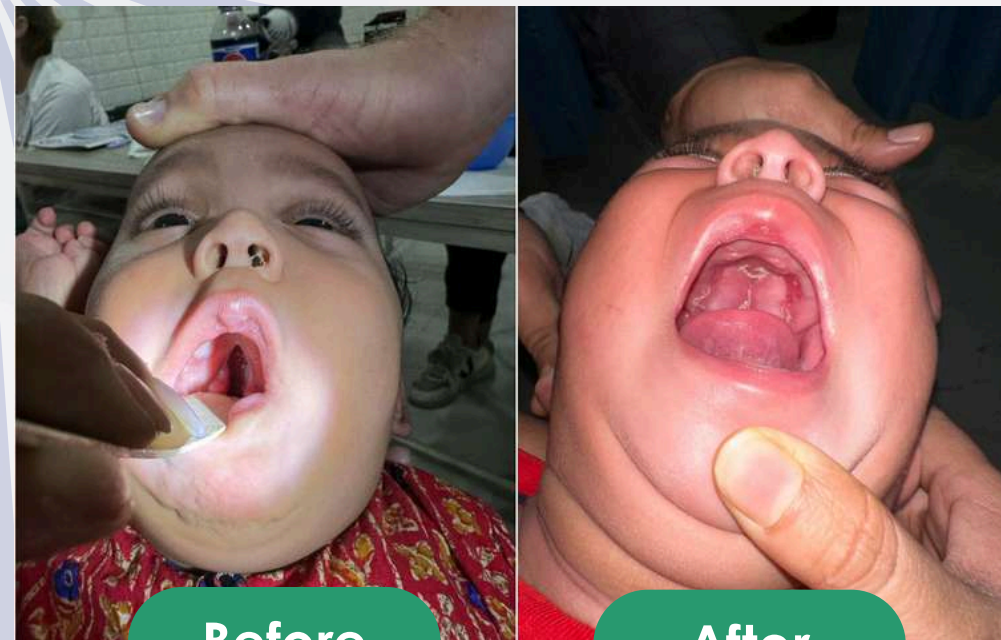
