- We HSWS set-up 4 number of vermicompost bed in the 4 different project target areas
- In the first project year we purchased 4 nos. Vermicompost bed, 8 kgs Vermi-(Earthworms)
- Each bed capacity- 500 ton vermi- compost manure; Shape- rectangular, Size- 12ft*4ft*12ft, Packing type- Plastic

C. Support & training to set up centralized Rain shelter (Poly House) for vegetable nursery raising

- In the first year HSWS formed 3 nos. of Poly green house in the three villages of Santuk G.P.
- Handholding support for marginalized farmers to ensure proper maintenance and utilization of the rain shelters.
- Distribution of high-quality nursery inputs, i.e. Seeds & Saplings to selected beneficiary farmers.
